


Long distance

There should be not more than five runners in each class.

W16	45-50	M16	55-60
W18	50-55	M18	60-65
W20	65-75	M20	70-75

Relay

Each team consists of **six runners**, one from each of the classes W16 and M16, one from each of the classes W18 and M18, and one from each of the classes W20 and M20.



- W18 and M18 starts at the same time.
- W18 changes to M16 and M18 changes to W16
- M20 do not go out until both W16 and M16 have been received for change.
- M20 changes to W20

All stages in the relay are forked.

Each district/country can start with 5 teams. Mixed and not full teams are **allowed** to start.

Names on the team members in the relay teams must be submitted in written form to the Organizers before or at the team leaders meeting on Saturday evening.

TEAM COMPETITION

The **Top 3** results for each country/district from each individual class and the three best results from the relay are added up to an overall time. Country/district with the shortest overall time in minutes and seconds is the winner of the team competition.

If a country/district doesn't have three runners who completed any of the individual classes or 3 approved relay teams, the country/district doesn't get an overall time.

REGISTRATION AND FEES

Participating fee for athletes and coaches is **80 euros**. Fee includes food from Friday evening, accommodation on hard floor, model event and starting on long distance and relay.

Registration deadline will be on **October 18**. Information of entries and payment will be provided in **September**.

There should be not more than five runners in each class.

RULES

Competition is organised according to Estonian Orienteering Federation competition rules In addition, IOF rules apply.
